
The competition is open to two-person and four-person teams. The qualifying events include pipe cutting, meter set build, service run, bell hole hand dig and a relay. To create the best teams possible, members can come from any combination of Gas departments (e.g. Construction, Division, Field Survey and Leak Survey). One Class A and one operator-qualified employee are required for each team.



The competition is open to 20 employees (one per division or until all slots are filled). The qualifying events include gas locate, electric locate and LFH-rapid locate.
