Gentlemen:

This confirms the Company's understanding of the settlement reached August 27, 1985, between the Company's Negotiating Committee and the Union's Negotiating Committee with respect to Subsection 301.4(a) of the Physical Agreement. The per diem amounts in Zones 1 - 5 inclusive shall be increased by \$.25 effective January 1, 1986. Zone 6 shall be increased by \$.75 effective January 1, 1986 and by an additional \$1.00 effective January 1, 1987.

The new per diem schedule shall be as follows:
