FACT FINDING COMMITTEE
MEMORANDUM OF DISPOSITION

North Bay Division Grievance No. 4-241-77-41
Fact Finding Committee File No. 499-77-96

Subject of Grievance:

Day shift employees at the Geysers Power Plant were working on a 202.17 schedule on an overhaul of Unit #5 and were sent to perform emergency work on Unit #9 during the hours of their shift. The Union requested overtime pay for the period of the assignment and this was denied by the Company.

Discussion:

The Fact Finding Committee met on June 8, 1977 and thoroughly reviewed the case. After considerable discussion it was agreed that the assignment of the grievants was not in violation of the Agreement. Paragraph M of the Clarification of Section 202.17 provides for assignments of this type.

The Joint Statement of Facts also contained language to the effect that Company and Union, at the Division level, disagreed on another point. The Company contended that the Geysers Power Plant was "one plant" consisting of several "units", although somewhat removed from each other. The Union contended that each "unit" constituted "a plant". The Fact Finding Committee agreed, that for the purposes of Section 202.17, the Geysers Power Plant (and all units thereof) constitutes one power plant.

Decision:

This case is settled without adjustment as there were no contractual violations by Company.

This case is closed.
