Darrel:

At our meeting on December 16, 1992 regarding the Underground Crew classifications and duties we discussed several items that I am listing below to confirm our joint understanding and agreement.

The job definitions for both the Underground Construction Crew Foreman and Underground Construction Journeyman provide that they "...engage in the installation, repair, and replacement of underground electric and gas facilities." We agreed that this underground crew could perform the above noted work even when only gas facilities or only underground electric facilities are involved.

In addition, two Electric Journeymen and a qualified observer may work on and energize a riser pole in association with an underground construction crew with the Underground Construction Crew Foreman in charge of the job. However, if the Underground Crew Foreman was from the gas line of progression the responsibility for the overhead part of the job would be given to a qualified electric department employee.
