Dear Mr. McNally:

Letter Agreement 98-93 established a system-wide Pre-Arranged Overtime Procedure for Gas Systems Maintenance and Gas Systems Operations. The California Gas Transmission 94-53 Committee formed a subcommittee in January 2001 to review joint concerns regarding the administration of the provisions outlined in Letter Agreement 98-93.


As a result of this review, the 94-53 Committee recommends to cancel Letter Agreement 98-93 effective April 30, 2001, thereby mutually agreeing to waive the 60 day cancellation clause.

Effective May 1, 2001, the number of pre-arranged hours for each employee will return to zero with future overtime assignments made in accordance with Title 208 of the Physical Agreement.
