Dear Mr. Zimmerman:

The Company proposes to eliminate the testing requirement of 25 w.p.m. to enter the classification of Operator Mechanic (Classification Codes 1705 / 1682) by new hires and employees designated as Same or Higher classifications. All other testing requirements for this classification will remain active.

The testing requirement of 25 w.p.m. will remain active for the classification of Maintenance Assistant I (Class Codes 0057 / 0058). As a result, an employee in the classification of Operator Mechanic would need to satisfy this testing requirement if placed into the Maintenance Assistant I classification through Title 206 of the Agreement.
