Dear Mr. Zimmerman:

The Company and Union entered into Letter Agreement 01-50-PGE on September 27, 2001 to implement the Company's policy for Emergency Active Military Leave. In that Letter Agreement, the parties agreed that regular employees would receive pay supplements equivalent to their base pay minus taxable wages received from the military for up to six months. Letter Agreement R1-02-07 extended this pay supplement through October 2002.

There are still employees who will be continuing their emergency active military service beyond October 2002. Therefore, the Company proposes to amend Letter Agreements 01-50-PGE and R1-02-07 to extend, on a one-time basis, this pay supplement through April 2003.
