
Dear Mr. Dalzell:

The Company and Union have discussed the installation of Solar Systems at various locations in San Francisco. These systems will be installed on Company facilities in most cases. This is work not normally performed by our crews as defined in Exhibit XVI of the Agreement. The parties in this case, however, want to use PG&E crews to perform the work. Company purposes to exempt this work from the provisions of Exhibit XVI and not to count the hours of work contracted out to free the PG&E crews to perform this work. Contractors replacing the PG&E crews would need to be signatory to IBEW Local 1245.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to the Company.


