Gentlemen:

It is our understanding that, during our current negotiations with respect to job definitions and lines of progression in the Department of Steam Generation, the parties agreed to change the wage rates of the Turbine Tender and Assistant Control Operator classifications at Oleum Power Plant to the following:

<u>Turbine Tender - Oleum Power Plant</u>	<u>Assistant Control Operator - Oleum Power Plant</u>
Start \$96.60 per week	Start \$ 98.50 per week
End 6 months 98.50 " "	End 6 months 101.70 " "

The parties further agreed that there would be no change of wage rate for any of the employees involved, and that it would merely be a change in title.

It is our further understanding that the parties agreed to extend the classification of Oiler to the Eureka Power Plant, to upgrade employees currently classified as Utilityman at Eureka Power Plant to the classification of Oiler, and to eliminate the classification of Utilityman at such plant.

If the foregoing agrees with your understanding of the agreements reached during these negotiations, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one copy of this letter to Company.
