Gentlemen:

The wage rate for the Utilityman classification in the Electric Department Shop at Sacramento currently held by Mr. Wm. Kirschner has been established at \$87.95 per week.

Based upon a resurvey of the duties of this classification, Company proposes to revise the wage rate to \$89.65 per week as follows:

Mechanic Sr.	41% of \$89.65 or \$36.75
Sheet Metal Worker	35% of \$90.80 or \$31.78
Blacksmith	9% of \$85.00 or \$ 7.65
Welder	15% of \$89.65 or \$13.45
Utilityman	100% \$89.63
