Gentlemen:

Our proposed letter agreement dated March 15, 1956, relative to the establishment of the classification of Utility Operator in the Substation Department is hereby withdrawn.

Due to the increased number of unit and unattended substations there are areas where a utility operator can be used to advantage. Therefore, Company proposes to establish the new classification of Utility Operator in the Substation Department with the following job definition and wage rate:

Utility Operator - Substation Department

An employee who inspects equipment for proper operation and performs the cleaning duties in the unattended substations assigned to him. In addition, he may be required to perform switching and minor maintenance within substations proper, prepare switching orders, switching codes and operating diagrams and give switching instructions to Troublemens and other employees.

This employee shall accrue classification seniority as a First Operator, Schedule II. When he is assigned to a Schedule I substation, he shall be upgraded to the Schedule I rate in accordance with the Agreement.

Wage Rate -- \$103.00 per week.


