Gentlemen:

This letter agreement supersedes our proposal on the same subject dated December 16, 1963.

Company proposes to establish the classification of Building Service Subforeman at the East Bay Division Office and to establish the classification of Building Maintenceman at the East Bay Division Office and at the Oakland Service Center, 4801 Oakport Road, Oakland. Company further proposes that the Building Service Subforeman Job Description applicable to San Francisco and Sacramento will also be applicable at the East Bay Division Office. Company further proposes that the Building Maintenceman Job Definition now applicable to the General Office and San Francisco be applicable to the two locations in East Bay Division. The weekly wage rates for these respective classifications will be the same as those established at the above locations. Company further proposes that the Lines of Progression effective August 1, 1958, included in Exhibit VI-H of Title 600, be considered applicable in East Bay Division.

Company further proposes to reclassify Mr. John Pellini from Head Janitor, Oakland, to Building Service Subforeman at the East Bay Division Office at the starting rate of the classification without reference to the bidding procedure. The effective date of the reclassification of Mr. Pellini will be the date of your approval of this letter agreement.


