Gentlemen:

Company proposes to establish a Tool Maintenance classification for use in the Divisions when needed. The wage rate for this classification will be \$74.70 per week and the job definition will be as follows:

Issues and receives tools required by gas and electric crews and does necessary clerical work. Repairs and maintains all types of hand tools including the replacing of handles and painting of pipe poles and ladders. Must be familiar with all types of live line tools.

Bids into or out of the classification shall be considered on the basis of the employee's qualifications and Company seniority as outlined in the Agreement under the preference sequence. Employees in the classification shall be given consideration for transfer into a vacancy in the starting job of their former line of progression.
