Gentlemen:

Company proposes to re-rate Morro Bay Switching Station from Schedule II to Schedule I.

At the same time, Company proposes to reclassify Mr. Paul Heinsen from his present classification of Electrician/Emergency Relief First Operator at this Station to Emergency Relief First Operator. For many years, Mr. Heinsen has not actually performed Electrician's duties although he has consistently been paid at the Electrician rate.

First Operators at this Station would be increased from \$136.90 per week to \$140.65 per week and Mr. Heinsen's rate would change from \$143.40/\$136.90 as dual Electrician/Emergency Relief First Operator to \$140.65 as Emergency Relief First Operator.

In addition, Company will establish another Emergency Relief First Operator position at this Station and proposes that the hours of work of this position be from 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on a Monday through Friday basis except when relief of other shifts is required.
