Gentlemen:

Our proposed letter agreement dated September 14, 1965, is hereby withdrawn.

Company proposes to establish the classification of Temporary Subforeman in the Pipe Line Operations Department for use in the General Section (Communication). The proposed job definition and wage rate are as follows:

Temporary Subforeman

An employee who is a working foreman engaged in the installation, service, repair, and maintenance of various types of communication equipment and in performing general electrical maintenance work incidental to the operation of gas transmission facilities. He shall have the personal qualifications of leadership and supervisory ability, the craft qualifications of a Communication Technician or Telephone Electrician depending upon the type of work being supervised, and shall be familiar with installation standards, safety rules, and other applicable rules and procedures. This classification shall be used on a temporary basis only.

Wage Rate - \$173.65 per week

If you are in accord with the foregoing proposal and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to Company.
