Gentlemen:

Our proposed letter agreement on the operation of Chili Bar Powerhouse dated July 31, 1964, is hereby withdrawn.

On the basis of the latest information provided us, the Company expects to begin operation of Chili Bar Powerhouse in January 1965. In order to avoid unnecessary future displacements of employees currently operating the American River Plant which will be inundated, Company will operate Chili Bar with Emergency Relief First Operators from American River and El Dorado Powerhouses and Brighton Substation. To accomplish this, Company proposes to modify the Job Definition of the Emergency Relief First Operator at Brighton Substation, commencing with the date of Company's operation of Chili Bar Powerhouse and ending when Company is permanently prevented from operating American River Power Plant by the construction of SMUD's American River Project. The proposed modification will read as follows:

Emergency Relief First Operator - Brighton Substation

An employee who is a First Operator, whose primary duties at one or more substations or powerhouses are to stand shifts as assigned, relieve other Operators and perform the duties of a Utility or Roving Operator at unattended substations or powerhouses. In addition, he may be required to perform electrical, mechanical and building maintenance at substations or powerhouses.

We are enclosing a proposed schedule for the Operators at the four plants involved, which was discussed at our meeting of September 29, 1964. As further discussed at that meeting, Company proposes to offer the chance to remain as the Emergency Relief First Operator at Brighton Substation to the

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three Emergency Relief First Operators at that station in order of their classification seniority and to consider the Emergency Relief First Operators at American River and El Dorado Powerhouses as Emergency Relief First Operators for the purpose of relief assignments at their respective powerhouses and to pay the Emergency Relief First Operator at American River Power Plant the Schedule II Emergency Relief rate when he is operating at Chili Bar Powerhouse.

If you are in accord with the foregoing proposal and attachment, and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to Company.
