Gentlemen:

In 1970 the position of Plant Clerk was established at the Geysers Power Plant because of both the expanding clerical workload at the Plant and some duties peculiar to this location which made the standard steam plant clerical classifications inappropriate.

Now due to the continued expansion of the Geysers Power Plant and the establishment of other support classifications such as Materials Facility Man, the special nature of the Plant Clerk no longer exists. Additionally, due to increased workload, additional clerical classifications are needed at the Plant, including a recently established First Plant Clerk position.

Based on the foregoing, the Plant Clerk position currently held by Mr. Paul Morales is no longer needed and will be reclassified. Accordingly, Company proposes, pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.13 of the Physical Agreement, to place Mr. Morales into the newly established First Plant Clerk at the Geysers Power Plant.
