Gentlemen:

Mr. R. H. Rodrigues is an Apprentice Electrician at King City where the only other maintenance employee at the headquarters, Mr. Overman, an Electrician, is ill and will be off work two to three months. In order to avoid laying Mr. Rodrigues off for this two or three-month period and to provide him some additional training not available at King City, Company proposes to assign Mr. Rodrigues, pursuant to Sections 206.13 and 205.19 of the Physical Agreement, to Salinas. Company further proposes that this assignment be in effect until such time as Mr. Overman returns to work at King City.

It is Company's intent to make this change without payment of any penalties relative to relocation or travel since this change is to Mr. Rodrigues' advantage and will provide him with a shorter commute than he would normally have at King City.

It is our understanding that the Union Business Representative serving this area is in accord with this proposal.
