Gentlemen:

This letter cancels and supersedes our letter of May 6, 1974 to you on the same subject.

Company has reviewed your proposal of March 18, 1974 regarding a change in hours for Electric T&D employees headquartered at the Richmond Service Center in East Bay Division.

In response, Company proposes pursuant to Subsection 202.16(b) of the Physical Agreement to change the hours of work from 8:00 a.m.-12:00 noon and from 12:30 p.m.-4:30 p.m. to 7:30 a.m.-11:30 a.m. and 12:00 noon-4:00 p.m. for employees located at the Richmond Service Center in the following classifications:

Line Subforeman, Lineman, Apprentice Lineman, Groundman, Inspector, T&D Equipment Operator, T&D Driver, Voltage Tester, Street Light Maintenceman, Cable Subforeman, Cable Splicer, Apprentice Cable Splicer, Cartman, Manhole Pumpman, Utility Operator, Electrician, Apprentice Electrician, Helper-Electrical Maintenance, and Senior Meterman.

In addition, Company proposes to change the hours of work of the Chief Distribution Operator at the Richmond Service Center from 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. to 7:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m., with the usual lunch period.

These proposals are made with the understanding that either party to this agreement may cancel the agreement upon giving the other party 30 days' written notice of cancellation. Such cancellation will result in the reinstatement of the hours of work in effect prior to this agreement.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to Company.
