Gentlemen:

Company will eliminate two positions of Heavy Truck Driver in the Division Stores of San Francisco Division and will establish two positions of Warehouseman at the same location.

Company proposes to reclassify the present Heavy Truck Drivers, Mr. William O. Willmuth and Mr. Joseph G. McClymond, to Warehousemen at the top of the Warehouseman rate (\$132.50 per week) without reference to the bidding procedure. Company further proposes these reclassifications be effective on the date agreement is reached between Company and Union.

These reclassifications are proposed to reflect the majority of the work actually being performed by Mr. Willmuth and Mr. McClymond, namely: ordering, receiving, disbursing and salvaging of materials.
