Gentlemen:

The wage rate of \$83.40 per week for the Utilityman classification in the Electric Department at Fairfield, Sacramento Division, currently held by Mr. E. J. Mohr, was computed on the basis of the following duties: Serviceman 25%, Storekeeper "C" 72%, and Helper 3%.

Based upon a resurvey of the duties of this classification, Company proposes to establish the rate of \$86.35 per week based upon the following breakdown:

Serviceman	50%	of \$91.35	or	\$45.68
Warehouseman	50%	of \$81.30	or	\$40.65
Utilityman	100%			\$86.33
