In order to provide adequate training for the shift supervisors at Humboldt Bay Steam Plant, Company wishes to fill these jobs well in advance of the completion of construction, i.e. next month.

Company, therefore, proposes to establish the classification of Watch Engineer at Humboldt Bay Steam Plant at this time. Proposals for other classifications will be forthcoming in the near future.

The proposed job definition and wage rate are as follows:

Watch Engineer - Humboldt Bay

A shift employee who is in direct charge of the steam and electric generating equipment and the operating personnel on his shift. He may do maintenance work during shut-down or during operation in case of bona fide emergencies.
