Company proposes the following job definitions for classifications as indicated:

## STEAM GENERATING STATIONS

### Insulation Mechanic

An employee whose principal duties are the application and removal of insulation on equipment in and about the plant, including boilers, turbines and all other types of equipment requiring insulation and/or water proofing. Also may erect or dismantle any staging necessary for his work. Since this work is intermittent in nature may also do painting and other maintenance work which normally falls within the Mechanic's classification.

### Apprentice Welder

An employee who does both electric and acetylene welding and cutting of metals as an assistant to or under the supervision of a welder on all types of power plant equipment and piping not requiring a Certified Welder; may work alone or with Helper on jobs on which he has been properly trained and instructed; must study and become familiar with the properties of metals and procedures for preheating, welding and stress relieving, and the use of all tools and equipment required in the preparation and completion of welds; may advance to the classification of Welder or Certified Welder upon completion of apprenticeship training and when a vacancy occurs, provided that satisfactory progress is shown in his ability to make proper welds. Since this work is intermittent in nature, also assists other journeymen and mechanics as required.

GAS DEPARTMENT

Apprentice Manhole Frammer

An employee engaged in performing Manhole Frammer's work as an assistant to or under the direction of a journeyman or higher classification; may advance to the classification of Manhole Frammer upon completion of apprenticeship training and when a job vacancy occurs.

DOMESTIC WATER DEPARTMENT

Apprentice Pipe Fitter

An employee engaged in performing Pipe Fitter's work as an assistant to or under the direction of a journeyman or higher classification; when proficient may be required to work alone on routine tasks such as service repairs and minor main repairs; may advance to the classification of Pipe Fitter upon completion of apprenticeship training and when a job vacancy occurs.

WATER COLLECTION DEPARTMENT

Apprentice Flume Repairman

An employee engaged in performing Flume Repairman's work as an assistant to or under the direction of a journeyman or higher classification; when proficient, may be required to work alone on routine tasks; may advance to the classification of Flume Repairman upon completion of apprenticeship training and when a job vacancy occurs.

DEPARTMENT OF GAS SUPPLY AND CONTROL

Apprentice Plant Mechanic

An employee engaged in performing Plant Mechanic's work as an assistant to or under the direction of a journeyman or higher classification; may advance to the classification of Plant Mechanic upon completion of apprenticeship training and when a job vacancy occurs.

CENTRAL SUPPLY DEPARTMENT  
MACHINE SHOP

Apprentice Sheet Metal Worker

An employee engaged in performing Sheet Metal Worker's duties as an assistant to or under the direction of a journeyman or higher classification; after becoming proficient in routine welding may be required to work alone when performing such duty; may advance to the classification of Sheet Metal Worker upon completion of apprenticeship training and when a job vacancy occurs.
