Effective September 1, 1955, Company and Union agreed to the establishment of a Utility Troublemán classification in the Electric Department in Mt. View. This classification was, and still is, held by Mr. H. C. Jones. Company proposes discontinuing the Utility Troublemán classification in Mt. View and establishing a Troublemán classification in Cupertino. The substation maintenance portion of the Utility Troublemán job is being returned to the Substation Maintenance Department.

Company proposes to reclassify Mr. Jones from Utility Troublemán to Troublemán without posting the Troublemán vacancy for bid and to transfer Mr. Jones from Mt. View to Cupertino.
