Gentlemen:

Due to the increasing development of gas fields in the Marysville area and the growing importance of the Gas Department work load at Marysville Substation, Company has found it necessary to establish a gas load center at Marysville Substation. In order to staff this center with qualified Gas Department employees and to relieve the Substation Operators of the majority of their gas work load, Company proposes to establish the classification of Pressure Operator at Marysville.

It is expected that the work load and duties will be comparable to those of other Pressure Operator jobs at San Rafael, Sacramento, Stockton and Fresno. Therefore, the wage progression applicable to those locations is proposed for Marysville, i.e.

Start	\$ 96.85 per week
End 6 months	99.80 " "
End 1 year	101.70 " "
