The wage rate of \$87.42 per week for the ~~Utilityman~~ <sup>RTW</sup> ~~Utilityman~~ <sup>COMBINATIONMAN</sup> classification in the Gas Department at Sonoma, currently held by Mr. Albert R. Olsen, was established on the following basis: Troubleman 51%, and Serviceman 49%.

Based upon a resurvey of the duties of this job, Company proposes to revise, as of November 1, 1952, such wage rate on the following basis:

Troubleman	70% of \$92.19 or \$64.53
Serviceman	30% of \$82.13 or \$24.64
