Gentlemen:

Due to the increase in its use of telemeters, remote control valves and other instruments in its gas plants, Company proposes to extend the classification of Apprentice Instrument Repairman where necessary to its gas plants. The deletion of the words "Steam Plants" after this classification in Wage Schedule I-C will accomplish this objective. The definition and wage rate for this classification are as follows:

APPRENTICE INSTRUMENT REPAIRMAN

An employee whose principal duties are to maintain, service and calibrate instruments and gages. Duties require moderate skill in the use of bench and hand tools including lathe used in connection with instrument repair work. Duties may also include work performed in the classification of Apprentice Machinist. When at the top wage rate of his classification he may transfer through bidding to the classification of Apprentice Machinist at his existing rate.
