Gentlemen:

The wage rate of \$84.98 per week for the Utilityman part of the Relief First Operator-Utilityman classification at Spaulding Powerhouse in Drum Division, now held by Mr. Arthur M. Justis, Jr., was established on the following basis: Mechanic 10%, Machinist 3%, Apprentice Machinist 63%, Electrician and Lineman 16%, Pipe Fitter 1%, Painter 1%, Rough Carpenter 1%, Lake Tender 4%, and Laborer 1%.

Based upon a resurvey of the duties of this job and the qualifications of Mr. Justis to whom it was recently awarded, Company proposes to revise, as of November 4, 1952, such wage rate as follows:

Apprentice Machinist	45% of \$82.13 or \$36.96
Apprentice Mechanic	15% of \$79.34 or \$11.90
Apprentice Lineman	3% of \$82.13 or \$ 2.46
Apprentice Electrician	17% of \$82.13 or \$13.96
Painter	3% of \$82.13 or \$ 2.46
Rough Carpenter	7% of \$72.38 or \$ 5.07
Lake Tender	5% of \$71.72 or \$ 3.59
Laborer	5% of \$66.08 or \$ 3.30
Utilityman	100% \$79.70
