Gentlemen:

The wage rate of \$78.76 per week for the Utilityman classification in the Electric Generation Department at Auburn, currently held by Mr. Thomas E. Warwick, was established on the following basis: Clerk D 35%, Apprentice Electrician 45%, Mechanic 2-1/2%, Rough Carpenter 2-1/2%, Machinist 10%, and Helper 5%.

Based upon a resurvey of the duties of this job, Company proposes to revise, as of November 20, 1952, such wage rate on the following basis:

Clerk C	61% of \$79.10 or \$48.25
Apprentice Electrician	30% of \$84.98 or \$25.49
Truck Driver Light	<u>9%</u> of \$76.62 or <u>\$6.90</u>
Utilityman	100% \$80.64
