Dear Mr. Dalzell:

The Company recognizes that the San Francisco underground electric system is a critical component of the Company's overall electric network. It has been several years since the Company and Union have reviewed UG Electric positions. Therefore, the Company proposes that within 6 months of the signing of this agreement, a Joint Company-Union Committee be established to review and update the job definitions and required skills of Underground Electric positions in Electric T&D.

In the interim, the Company proposes to temporarily increase the Cableman rate of pay from \$45.62/hour to \$46.61/hour. Any permanent change in the Cableman rate of pay will be discussed after the Joint Company-Union Committee has made their recommendations. This wage adjustment will not take place until SAP programming has been completed (approximately 30 days from the signing of this agreement).

Either party may cancel this agreement by providing the other party 30 days written notice.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to the Company.
