Gentlemen:

Company proposes to reclassify Mr. A. J. Toscano of Los Banos from Service Mechanic - Gas at \$134.75 per week to Gas Mechanic at \$136.90 per week without reference to the bidding procedure. It is further proposed this reclassification be effective July 1, 1962.

An analysis of the duties of Mr. Toscano revealed the need for this reclassification as the majority of his duties are within the job definition of Mechanic and the remaining duties are common to both the Mechanic and the Service Mechanic classifications. The classification and duties were carried over from Coast Counties Gas and Electric Company.
