Please refer to your letter of May 13, 1965 with respect to the reclassification of Mr. George Latshaw, Truck Driver, Light in the Water Collection Department in De Sabla Division.

After reviewing Mr. Latshaw's assignments, Company proposes, under the provisions of Subsection 206.1(e) of the Agreement, to reclassify Mr. Latshaw from Truck Driver, Light (\$123.75 - \$128.60 per week) to Utility Truck Driver, Heavy, with the following job definition and wage rate:

Utility Truck Driver, Heavy

An employee who is a Truck Driver, Heavy and, in addition, performs the duties of a Labor Foreman who is supervising men on unskilled types of work.

Proposed Wage Rate - \$132.50 per week

When work is performed in other higher classifications (i.e., Flume Repairman, Labor Foreman who is supervising men on semiskilled work, etc.), the provisions of Section 205.3 shall apply.

Company further proposes that this reclassification be effective on the date Company and Union reach agreement on the matter.

If you are in accord with the foregoing proposals and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to Company.
