<u>Field Garage Mechanic "A"</u>	-	Start	-	\$94.55 per week
		End 1 yr.	-	\$96.40 per week

This job will require the qualifications of a Journeyman Mechanic with experience in major repair of heavy construction equipment. Must be capable of diagnosing trouble and making necessary repairs as well as ordering parts for such equipment as cranes, tractors, crawlers, mixers, trenching machines, hole diggers and heavy duty trucks, both gasoline and diesel type.

<u>Field Garage Mechanic "B"</u>	-	Start	-	\$84.90 per week
		End 6 mos.	-	\$86.95 per week
		End 1 yr.	-	\$89.50 per week

This job requires the capacity to perform minor repair and service work on all cars, trucks and construction equipment. Work to consist of such repairs and adjustments as changing spark plugs, tune-ups, repairing lights, adjusting brakes, servicing accessories, general servicing and other work of like nature not requiring the knowledge or supervision of a Field Garage Mechanic "A".
