Gentlemen:

As a result of the recent ratification, Mr. Wayne E. Rowe, Warehouseman/  
Heavy Truck Driver in the Division Stores in Fresno, was reclassified to Warehouseman/  
Truck Driver, effective July 1, 1966.

Effective September 20, 1966, Company will eliminate the dual classifica-  
tion of Warehouseman/Truck Driver in the Division Stores in Fresno and will establish  
the classification of Truck Driver in the Hydro Superintendent's Office in Fresno.

Under the provisions of Subsection 206.1(e) of the Agreement, Company  
proposes to reclassify Mr. Wayne E. Rowe to the newly established Truck Driver posi-  
tion in the Division Hydro Superintendent's Office at his same weekly wage rate  
(\$139.30 per week). It is our understanding that this matter has been discussed  
between Union's Representative and the Division Personnel Department in Fresno.

If you are in accord with the foregoing proposal and agree thereto, please  
so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter  
to Company.
