Gentlemen:

As a result of the Review Committee decision, R. C. File No. 250, Company proposes to amend the job definition of the Meter Subforeman classification in the Electric Meter Department to read as follows:

Meter Subforeman

An employee who is (a) working foreman in charge of a crew of not more than four men (exclusive of himself) engaged in performing any kind of meter setting, servicing, testing and repairing; or

An employee who is an assistant to the foreman in a large shop and who is engaged in performing and supervising any kind of meter servicing, testing and repairing.

In either case, he shall have the personal qualifications of leadership and supervisory ability, the craft qualifications of a Senior Meterman and must be familiar with meter installation, standard testing procedures, accounting practices and safety rules.


