Gentlemen:

Company intends to eliminate the six Fitter positions in the Gas Measurement and Control groups in Sacramento Division and to utilize the Gas Measurementman classification in accomplishing the work.

Company, under the provisions of Subsection 206.1(e) of the Agreement, proposes to:

- (1) Reclassify the six Fitter positions to Apprentice Gas Measurementman positions.
- (2) Waive any apprentice entrance requirement for the incumbent Fitters and assign them to the new positions.
- (3) Provide for automatic progression to the Gas Measurementman classification for those who qualify, or provide for reassignment to other Fitter duties for those incumbents who either will not accept participation in the training, or who fail to meet the training standards.

In accordance with the 1966 IBEW settlement, these employees will remain as Fitters for wage, bidding, and demotion purposes until they complete their apprenticeships and are fully qualified academically and mechanically.
