Gentlemen:

Mr. W. E. Foster is currently employed as a Garageman in East Bay Division and has, since the date of his employment, been upgraded to Light Truck Driver as a Pony Express Driver. Mr. Foster was employed on July 5, 1966. The temporary assignment was made because the Company was studying the possibility of transferring the mail route from East Bay Division to the General Office. This study has been completed and a determination made to make such transfer.

Company now proposes to reclassify Mr. Foster from Garageman (Light Truck Driver, Temporary) in East Bay Division to Mail Clerk Driver in the General Office under the provisions of Subsections 206.1(e) of the Physical Agreement and 19.1(b) of the Clerical Agreement without reference to the remainder of the demotion procedure or the bidding procedure of either contract.
