Gentlemen:

In accordance with the provisions of Section 10.7 of the Clerical Agreement, Company proposes that the following regular hours of work be changed, during the calendar year 1967, for Meter Readers in the Sacramento District, from 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM, to:

7:00 AM to 3:30 PM during that period of the calendar year when Pacific Daylight Saving Time is established for this State.

The employees will have a lunch period of one-half hour.

We understand that the reasons for the change have been discussed with the Business Representative serving the Sacramento Division, as well as the employees who would be concerned by the change. Briefly, the revision of the new hours of work, during the summer months, will allow the Meter Readers to complete meter reading schedules during the cooler part of the day. The change will also enable the clerks to ready the books for transmission to the General Office for processing and billing that day.
