2350 HEAD POWER SURVEYOR

An employee who performs the duties of a power surveyor and is the lead man directing, training and checking the work of five or more power surveyors.

2353 POWER SURVEYOR

An employee who surveys customers connected electric load and uses and records the data relating thereto for the purpose of analyzing and applying the proper rate schedules; checks and sketches customer's wiring; locates and reports rate and rule deviations, metering irregularities, low voltage, overloads, or other abnormal conditions; may be required to survey gas installations; is qualified to discuss rates and use with customers.

2482 ASSISTANT PUMP TESTER

An employee who assists in the testing of pumps by performing such duties as taking well soundings, drilling discharge or intake pipe, installing pitot tubes, making rpm tests, and connecting manometers. In addition, he assists the pump tester in the compilation of reports as well as the care of equipment used in connection with pump testing.

1000 COMPLAINT INSPECTOR (San Francisco Division)

An employee who possesses a general knowledge of gas and electric meters and appliances and whose major duty is contacting customers and making investigations with respect to complaints registered. This may require "premises tests," searching for metering irregularities, tracing lines to determine connected loads, analyzing customer accounts and the performance of other related work.
