Gentlemen:

We recently discussed with you a grievance concerning the request for transfer of a Stockton Division employee. As a means of settling this grievance, Company proposes to appoint the grievant and one other employee to Warehouseman and Building Maintenceman job vacancies, respectively, without reference to the bidding procedures, in accordance with the provisions of Section 205.19.

1. Mr. Carl D. Johnston, Warehouseman, Stockton, will be appointed to a Building Maintenceman job vacancy in Stockton.
2. The Warehouseman job vacancy created by the appointment of Mr. Johnston will be filled by Mr. M. T. Linker, Helper, Modesto. Mr. Linker will be placed in the Warehouseman classification at the wage step that he would have attained had he been appointed March 10, 1967, and credited with classification seniority as a Warehouseman from that date.

It is understood that neither of the above appointments will involve a retroactive pay adjustment.
