Gentlemen:

The wage rate of \$78.61 per week for the Utilityman classification in the Electric Generation Department at Elmer Peter House, currently held by Mr. L. V. Barker, was established on the following basis: Troubleshman 40%, First Operator 20%, Meter Reader 5%, and Laborer 35%.

Based upon a re-survey of the duties of this job, Company proposes to revise as of February 2, 1953, the wage rate of this classification on the following basis:

Troubleshman	55% of \$92.19 or \$50.70
First Operator	20% of \$78.20 or \$15.64
Laborer	20% of \$44.08 or \$8.82
Ditch Patrolman	5% of \$44.08 or \$2.20
Utilityman	100% \$77.36
