In order to accurately reflect the duties of the Utility Serviceman classification at Willits, Company proposes to revise the job description of this classification at Willits in the following manner:

2221 Utility Serviceman - North Bay Division

An employee who is a Gas Serviceman and, in addition, performs the duties of a Water Treatment Plant Operator, Schedule I. Such an employee must have a Waterworks Operator's Certificate, Grade II. *gju*

Such an employee shall be paid the wage rate of a Gas Serviceman and, for the purposes of Title 205 "Job Bidding and Promotion" and Title 206 "Demotion and Layoff Procedure," be considered as a Gas Serviceman.
