Gentlemen:

Recognizing the uniqueness of conditions at the Geysers Power Plant due to its remote and isolated location which precludes living in the vicinity of the Plant, Company proposes the following adjustments for employees at the Plant:

1. Application of the conditions of Section 202.9 which provide for a workday of 8 consecutive hours to all maintenance employees at the Plant.
2. Adjustment of the pay schedule of the (1716) Power Plant Operator classification at the Geysers as follows:

Start	- \$294.35 per week
End 6 mos.	- 315.05 per week
End 12 mos.	- 322.05 per week

Company considers these adjustments as an equitable and final solution to the problem the parties have discussed on numerous occasions.
