Gentlemen:

Due to manning requirements at the new Edenvale Service Center in San Jose, Company intends to reclassify two existing Equipment Mechanic positions at the San Jose Garage to Lead Equipment Mechanic and to transfer these reclassified positions to the new garage. Currently, the Equipment Mechanic positions are assigned at the San Jose Garage to Mr. Lester M. Tharp and to Mr. Frank H. Durrenberg. In order to fill the Lead Equipment Mechanic position with the least amount of disruption to employees, Company proposes to assign Mr. Tharp and Mr. Durrenberg to the Lead Mechanic position at the Edenvale Service Center pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.13 of the Physical Agreement. It is our understanding that both Mr. Durrenberg and Mr. Tharp are the senior volunteers for this transfer.
