Gentlemen:

Company has recently installed new equipment at Larkin Substation in San Francisco Division which has doubled the capacity of this station. The changes have increased the workload and responsibilities of the First Operators at Larkin to the point where the wage rate for the First Operators should be changed. Therefore, Company proposes to increase the wage rate of the First Operator classification at Larkin Substation from \$157.40 per week (Schedule III) to \$170.40 per week (Schedule II), effective October 1, 1967.
