By letter agreement dated June 23, 1975, certain procedures for the handling of emergency overtime were negotiated for the San Joaquin Division Electric Department. One of the items contained in the letter agreement was the adjustment of all employees to zero hours of recorded emergency overtime at the time of initial sign-up on August 1, 1975.

Company proposes, pursuant to Section 212.12 of the Physical Agreement, to adjust employees in the Division General Services Department to zero hours of recorded emergency overtime on August 1, 1975 in a manner similar to the Electric Department.
