Gentlemen:

In December, 1972, the hours of work of Underground Storage Maintenance personnel at McDonald Island were changed to 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. These hours were necessary because of the construction activity on the Island and the limited access road and ferry facilities on the Island.

The pipe line construction work has been completed, and the major portion of drilling work is completed. As a consequence, General Construction forces have been reduced, thus congestion on the Island has been alleviated. Accordingly, pursuant to Section 202.16 (b) of the Physical Agreement, Company proposes to return Underground Storage Maintenance personnel to the normal hours of work of 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. with the usual lunch hour.

It is our understanding that the Local Union Business Representative serving this area is in accord with this proposal.
