Gentlemen:

During the course of Mr. R. J. Mountz's employment as a Gas Serviceman in San Jose Division, he has suffered various industrial back injuries. On June 9, 1975, Mr. Mountz was permanently rated as 33% permanently disabled. He is precluded from lifting and repetitive bending or stooping and as a consequence precluded from working in his regular Gas Serviceman classification.

Accordingly, Company proposes, pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.13 of the Physical Agreement, to place Mr. Mountz into a vacant Relief Service Operator classification in San Jose.
