Gentlemen:

Division Climbing Schools are not held at all District headquarters, thus making it necessary for transfer applicants to beginning climbing vacancies to travel to some other headquarters. The language of the Physical Agreement Sections 201.7 thru 201.12 spell out the proper procedure for handling travel time in such cases.

The Clerical Agreement, however, has no such provision and could work a hardship on clerical employees who wish to attend a Division Climbing School at another headquarters in order to qualify for transfer to a beginning climbing vacancy.

Company proposes to apply the language of Sections 201.7 thru 201.12 inclusive of the Physical Agreement to Clerical employees where appropriate.
