Gentlemen:

As a result of an industrial back injury, Mr. J. H. Meulenberg is unable to perform the duties of his Gas T&D Helper classification in San Jose Division. Mr. Meulenberg has been assigned to the Division Gas Load Center pursuant to Section 108.2 of the Physical Agreement and can perform the duties of a Pressure Operator. As a result of this, Company proposed on October 7, 1975, to place Mr. Meulenberg into a vacant Pressure Operator position. Agreement on this proposal could not be reached apparently because of the fact that the Pressure Operator vacancy had been posted pursuant to requirements of Title 205 of the Physical Agreement.

Currently, there is another vacant Pressure Operator position in San Jose; and it is the Division's intent not to post this position but to again propose, pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.13 of the Physical Agreement, to place Mr. Meulenberg into the Pressure Operator position.

It is our understanding that the Local Union Business Representative serving the San Jose area is in agreement with this proposal.
